Healthcare for Black Canadians



Racism, discrimination, poverty & other structural & systemic inequalities strongly impact the physical, emotional and mental health of all Black women in Canada

Black women are **overrepresented** in national rates for **most significant chronic illnesses**, like **cancer**, **cardiovascular disease and HIV/AIDS**





Ontario is home to **half of the country's Black population,** but the province has assigned **limited healthcare resources** to address the needs of Black
women

Anti-Black racism is a key factor in the high rates of chronic illness like depression, which further undermines Black women's ability to thrive





Canada doesn't have a national Black health strategy
